Parent Advisor Expectations

1. Understand the program and activities of Peregrine School and the Peregrine Project.
2. Attend and freely participate in board meeting discussions and other board activities and/or serve on one of our committees/task forces. How and how much you participate as a parent advisor can be based on your interest and availability.
3. Serve for a minimum of one year, if possible.
4. Keep any work of the board that involves sensitive issues confidential.
5. Attend most school-wide events open to the public (2-3 events are held per year) and actively participate as a volunteer (e.g., filling a shift).
6. Represent the organization in a positive and professional way when speaking with other Peregrine families and community members at large.
7. Actively participate in annual goal setting and future planning. Work in good faith with board members, fellow parent advisors and Peregrine staff toward achievement of agreed-upon goals.
